




Installing a New WolfePak Version Using a Removable Drive (ie Flash Drive)

For users who do not have internet access on your WolfePak machine. This procedure does require an internet connection (preferably a high speed connection) on a different computer (home, library, etc)


DOS clients should go to the Global Maintenance Menu, and choose option "A" Install new version from Internet. It will run the program wpUpdate.exe.

Windows clients need to go to the Utilities Menu in WolfePak. Then under Global, go into System Authorization (either # 91 or 92.) You should select the New Advanced Options button which allows you to do an automatic download and installation of the most recent version of WolfePak from the WolfePak FTP site to a removable drive (such as flash drive).




(the program looks for wpUpdate.exe and attempts to run it)


If wpUpdate.exe does NOT exist, then the following error message is displayed:




If wpUpdate.exe exists, then it calls it and WolfePak Utilities is closed down. Next, select the "Prepare Removable Drive for WolfePak Update" option and Enter the Removable Drive Letter. Select the OK button to begin the prepare process.




If a recent Download has been performed, then you will see the following confirmation message (Select OK to continue or Cancel to stop):




After it is finished, you should see a note that the removable drive was successfully prepared:



Take it to a computer that has Internet access and run wpUpdate on the removable drive. The default “Select a Download/Install Options” is set to do a full update. Click the OK button to continue.



The Download process will get all authorized items based on the selected Download Option. After it is finished, you should see a note that the files have been downloaded to the removable drive and to connect it back to the WolfePak machine to complete the installation.




To complete the installation:

DOS clients should go to the Global Maintenance Menu, and choose option “A” Install new version from Internet.

Windows clients should run WolfePak again, go to the Utilities Menu, under Global, go into System Authorization (either # 91 or 92), and select the Advanced Options button.

Then, Select the “Install WolfePak Update from Removable Drive” option and then specify the “Removable Drive Letter”. Select the OK button to continue.



The installation process will install the downloaded WolfePak items. After it is finished, you should see a note that the WolfePak software has been updated successfully.
